

Organisation and proposed scenario for the complex examination¹

- 1. The chairperson
 - a. welcomes the participants and introduces the reviewers,
 - b. asks the secretary to keep the minutes,
 - c. calls upon the candidate to present his/her scientific work (a 20-25-minute presentation).
- 2. The candidate presents his/her thesis highlighting his/her new scientific achievements.
- 3. The chairperson calls upon the reviewer to present his/her opinion on the submitted work.
- 4. The reviewer gives his/her opinion.
- 5. The chairperson calls upon the candidate to reply.
- 6. The candidate answers the questions.
- 7. The chairperson calls upon the questioners to ask about the major and minor subjects.
- 8. The candidate answers the questions asked.
- 9. After the reply, the chairperson asked whether the answer was satisfactory. If the answer is negative, (s)he provides an opportunity for a discussion.
- 10. The chairperson closes the examination.
- 11. The chairperson closes the meeting.
- 12. The attendance sheet containing the signatures of the participants shall be attached to the minutes of the complex examination including all questions and answers.
